Usage Recommendations:

- **Application:** Pour Easy Dip into a clean container—ensure stems can be dipped into 2 in/ 5 cm of solution. Quickly dip flower stems into the solution. Immediately place flowers into Chrysal Professional 2 or other conditioner for best results.
- **Storage:** Keep in cool, dry, and dark conditions (optimal temperature range 41°F and 77°F / 5°C to 25°C).
- **Shelf Life:** 24 months in sealed packaging when stored correctly.
- **Maximum Treatment Time:** Use solution for 1 day only or discard sooner if it becomes cloudy or discolored.
- **Compatibility:** Do not use in unprotected metal containers (zinc, copper, iron). Do not mix old and fresh solutions.
- **Disposal:** Residual solution may be safely disposed of via the sewer systems.
